A further point back in third place was Trevor and Gail Franklin. For everyone else not playing this event there was a game of single stable ford which attracted a field of 70 players. The best scores in of 43 points were achieved by David Thorp and David Leach more than enough to win both the minor grades. Best in for A Grade was Dan Kelly with a score of 40 points. A score of 37 points down to a count back was required to win a ball down the line. John Gay scored the two nearest the pins on the fourth and eighth holes. Back to Thursdays event where the aforementioned Stanton blitzed we had Richard Perry runner up in A Grade with a score of 41 points just the point in advance of Peter Skinner in third place. George Gray won the B Grade event with a score of 39 points playing off his handicap of 29 on a count back from Mick Howsin with Peter Fedorenko in third place with a score of 37 points. Both the semi finals of the 2018 Summer Cup have been played with Elton Shipway defeating Pieter Vander Horst at the nineteenth and Tolly Baharis defeating Peter Fedorenko 3 up with the one hole to play. Baharis, a big game performer, goes into the final as a slight favorite.
