Then 47 players came out for a game on Thursday with John Garner scoring a very nice 43 points to win the B Grade event playing off his handicap of 29, four points to the better of John Obrien and a further two points to Rick Falcone in third place. The A Grade event was taken out by Trevor Male with a score of 41 points playing off his mark of 10 three points in advance of Darren Stanton who claimed the runners up prize on a count back from John Carvill. A red hot Stanton provided the days highlight by scoring an eagle two on the par four second hole after driving the green then sinking his putt. Stanton sure is having a period of form to remember and was awarded the 21 balls for his eagle. A score of 36 points or better was required to win a ball down the line. A field of 31 presented to the starter on Good Friday with Ben Maroney scoring 39 points to win the B Grade event playing off his handicap of 24 whilst Steve Clark won the A Grade event with a score of 36 points playing off his handicap of 16. A final score of 35 points or better was needed to win a ball down the line. A field of 84 played on Saturday with Joe Tonso shooting a round of 42 points, the day's best, winning the B Grade event playing off his handicap of 19. Harry Huyskens had the next best score with a round of 39 points to win the C Grade event playing off a handicap of 21. The A Grade event was won by Steve Kohut with a score of 36 points playing off his mark of just 7, right on his handicap. A final score of 37 points was needed to win a ball down the line. Easter Monday concludes the Easter Cup with the final results to be reported next week due to press requirements. Last Thursday week saw the conclusion of the 2018 Twilight Season with Peter Bogart being crowned the overall champion.
