BAHARIS DOMINATES

The bad weather duly arrived on Saturday with the prevailing cold , wet and windy conditions impacting greatly on those keen enough , some may choose another term , for their weekly golfing fix. It was the two events in one on Saturday with the playing of the July Monthly Medal as well as the second and final round of the time honored Cox Cup. Tolly Baharis a clear leader after the first round came out and completely dominated the day by scoring 82 off the stick to give him a net round of 65 which combined with his first round of net 62 was more than enough to be claimed the Cox Cup champion for 2018.

Baharis finished the thirteen shots clear of the next best which were Terry Garratt and Peter Johnson in a tie for second. As well as winning the Cup Baharis,s score was also good enough to win the Monthly Medal three shots to the better of Peter Johnson. From the original field of 50 who braved the conditions only the total of 30 completed their round due to the wild weather. Just the two players, Baharis and Johnson were able to play to their handicap or better. Gus McKillop had the best scratch score for the day with a round of 78 off the stick. Sepp Krummenacher was the other winner for the day with a handicap round of 74 to claim victory for the B Grade event. Grant McLure certainly had his iron tee shots dialed in by claiming the three nearest the pins on the 4TH , 9TH and 14TH holes. The other star golfer for the week was Pieter Vander Horst who scored a brilliant 73 off the stick for

Thursdays round of single stable ford which equated to a net round of 39 points playing off his handicap of just seven. His round included an eagle three on the par five first hole as well as a birdie four on the par five seventeenth hole. Vander Horst was awarded the 14 balls for his eagle. John Carvill also had a nice round with a final score of 38 points to finish runners up for the A Grade event. Best in for the B Grade event was Tony Power with a final score of 36 points playing off his handicap of 21. A score of 35 points or better down to a count back was required to win a ball down the line, whilst on Saturday a score of 77 to a count back was required. Next week is a game of single par.
